- Sets ambitious and concrete targets over the next 10 years, such as: Tree planting, Solar energy deployment, Waste reduction, Carbon neutral schools, Cleaner-energy car models

Experts no longer believe that the COVID-19 pandemic will slow sustainability progress

The top corporate sustainability leaders have remained consistent over the last few years



Some new companies enter the ranking as more integrate sustainability into their core business models In Asia corporate sustainability is varied - CDL and Tata are most recognized but no clear leader in the region

NGOs are perceived to be making the most significant contribution to advancing sustainable development
