
Plastics Treaty Talks Stall While Public Feels Impacted by Plastics and Sees Health Risks as Top Concern



70% say they are greatly or moderately affected by

Consumers' concerns about single-use plastics:

- Human health impacts affecting our bodies (35%)
- Impacts on animals/biodiversity (20%)
- Climate change (18%)
- Plastics in the ocean (18%)
- Litter in cities/towns (9%)
